## HOUSEHOLD ITEMS



### Appliances & Metals

- Auto parts (non-greasy)
  - Barbecues
  - Blenders
  - Dishwashers
  - Dryers
  - Electric lawnmowers (remove battery first)
  - Exercise equipment
  - Metal lawn furniture
  - Metal push and gas lawnmowers (drain oil and gasoline first)
  - Microwaves
  - Stoves
  - Toasters
  - Washers
- NOT ACCEPTED**  
Containers that previously or currently contain gas, oil, chemicals, or paint.



### Car Seats & Boosters

- Expired child car seats and boosters



### Foam Blocks & Packing Peanuts

- Packing peanuts (any color; keep in a box or bag)
- White foam/expanded polystyrene blocks (look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol)

All items must be clean and dry.

### NOT ACCEPTED

Urethane foam cushions, hot tub covers, and expanded polypropylene or foam insulation.



### Rigid Plastics

- Buckets
- Children's toys
- Coolers
- Laundry baskets
- Plastic lawn furniture
- PVC pipe
- Sports bottles

### NOT ACCEPTED

Blinds and office chairs.

## ELECTRONICS



### Lead Acid Batteries

- Lead acid batteries for cars, trucks, boats, and motorcycles

### NOT ACCEPTED

AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D batteries, rechargeable batteries, and cellphone batteries.



### Electronic Equipment

- Cell phones
- Computer keyboards
- Computer mice
- Copiers
- DVD players
- Fax machines
- Printers
- Scanners
- Stereo equipment
- VCRs

Be sure to delete or remove personal data stored in your electronics.



## BULKY ITEMS



### Mattresses & Box Springs

- Mattresses **FEE:** \$15 each
- Box Springs **FEE:** \$15 each

### NOT ACCEPTED

Wet or soiled items, furniture, or frames.



### Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, & Water Heaters

- Refrigerators and freezers **FEE:** \$28 each
- Air conditioners **FEE:** \$33 each
- Water heaters with insulation coating **FEE:** \$5 each



### Porcelain Toilets & Sinks

- Porcelain toilets and sinks
- Remove toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings.  
**FEE:** \$15 each

## GARAGE & WOOD WASTE



### Clean Scrap Wood

- Milled lumber
- Plywood
- Pallets

These wood products must be untreated and unpainted. No need to remove nails.

### NOT ACCEPTED

Furniture, yard waste, stumps, branches, construction, or demolition material.



### Propane Tanks

- Empty residential propane tanks **FEE:** \$5 each
- Small empty camping stove tanks **FEE:** \$1 each

## DO NOT BRING

### TVs, Computers, & Monitors

TVs, computers, computer monitors, tablets, e-readers, and portable DVD players are **not** accepted at this event.

### Car & Truck Tires

**LIMIT:** Each car may dispose of up to six passenger tires (18 inches and smaller)

- Car tire without rim **FEE:** \$1 each
- Car tire on a rim **FEE:** \$3.50 each
- Truck tire without rim **FEE:** \$5 each
- Truck tire on a rim **FEE:** \$15 each

### NOT ACCEPTED

Oversized tires.

### Fluorescent, CFL, & HID Lights

Fluorescent, CFL, and HID lights are **not** accepted at this event. Find locations to recycle them at no cost at [lightrecycle.org](http://lightrecycle.org). Fluorescents are also accepted at the Fatoria Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Site.
